Weatherdock Inc. is on target for the BOOT 2010

During the world largest yacht and boat show, the BOOT2010 in Duesseldorf, Weatherdock Inc. will be on location there with a own booth in hall 11 – B27. From the 25th up to the 31st of January three new products will be presented to the interested general public. One of these products, the easyRESCUE is a world premiere.

Weatherdock would like to show by this commitment how important it is to push the technical equipment level even on pleasure boats to greater heights – for safety reasons.

Highlight at the Weatherdock booth will certainly be the easyRESCUE – a novel AIS-based maritime emergency channel. This system makes searching MOB persons much more easier. It transmits the live position permanently on a standard FM frequency: the AIS signal. So every vessel in the surrounding with an AIS-receiver is able to locate the MOB person on the chart plotter as a marker and could initiate the rescue.

A product development is the easyAIS-IS. This device based on the easyAIS contains a splitter which separates AIS and other signals without any loss. So full power is guaranteed at any time. PC's will connected easily with USB.

Useful on pleasure boats will also be the easyN2Kconnect. The easyN2Kconnect converts the AIS-Data, which are in the NMEA 0183 Code into the new NMEA 2000. So all AIS-devices could be integrated in the new PC and chart plotter
